



Funding and Fees

We accept the free entitlement childcare vouchers for up to 15 hours per week, term time only (38 weeks per year) and working childcare vouchers and disadvantaged 2-year-old funding. Any child who is not eligible for funding will be charged at £30 per session, which will be invoiced half termly upfront, we can offer alternative methods of payment, if this is difficult for some parents/carers, such as paying weekly instead, which can be discussed and arranged with management staff.

If your child is aged under two years old, we would only be able to accept either working childcare vouchers or payment for sessions attended priced at £30 per session, which would be invoiced half termly to yourself. If parents find it too expensive to pay half termly upfront, we can offer alternative methods of payment such as paying weekly instead, which can be discussed and arranged with management staff.

We do ask parents with funded children for a voluntary contribution half termly of £15 per child to help towards costs for nappies, suncream, nappy rash cream and snacks daily, and extra optional activities such as special events. Alternative arrangements can be arranged with management staff if this is not suitable for parents/ carers by looking at alternative methods such as paying smaller amounts or paying weekly rather than half termly, etc.

Parents/carers can refer to their contracts to view which are your free entitlement hours, and any extra costs you MAY occur as extras eg late collection as per policy pack, (voluntary) contribution fees for funded children as explained below.

Additional hours which could incur extra costs for parents/carers Early years care - late collection: the purchase of additional hours (even for funded children) would be in the event of extra hours occurred as per policy agreement for late child collection.
